



## Reopening Plan 2020-2021 School Year

### 1. General

- Coshocton Christian School will do its best to promote safety in the school building.
- CCS will implement recommended safety protocols to the best degree possible. Cleaning and disinfecting will take place during as well as after the school day. All staff members will be responsible for helping with cleaning and disinfecting their location. There will be cleaning supplies in each classroom. There will also be hand sanitizer in each classroom and area of the school building.
- CCS will be operating under the calendar that was approved by the school board. The first official day for students is Wednesday, August 26, 2020.
- Staff with a temperature over 100 degrees Fahrenheit or Covid 19 symptoms must immediately go home.
- CCS is expecting parents to conduct a wellness check prior to sending a student to school. Students with a temperature over 100 degrees Fahrenheit or symptoms of Covid 19 must stay home.
- CCS wants all families to realize that some level of risk will always be present when children and employees occupy school facilities.

### 2. Communication Procedures

- If a student/staff member has been diagnosed with a Covid 19 positive case, persons that were exposed by the contacted person will be notified.
- The Health Department will determine the length of isolation and quarantine periods necessary of the affected person.

#### **Student health issues that are NOT diagnosed as Covid 19**

- The duration of homestay for a child sent home with a fever is 48 hours fever free without medication AND improvement of all other symptoms.

#### **Students who become ill at school**

- Students who show symptoms of sickness, including a fever will be placed in a separate room supervised by school staff until they are transported home.

### 3. Face Coverings/Masks

- The wearing of face coverings has been mandated by the governor.
- School employees will be required to wear a face covering when physical distancing is not possible.
- Parents must have a note on file if they are claiming an exemption from face coverings.

### 4. Classroom information

- CCS will make effort to social distance in the classroom setting.
- Student desks will be disinfected frequently throughout the day and every evening.

- Students will be required to sanitize their hands entering the classroom.
- Students will be required to sit in their assigned seats every single day.

#### **5. Recess**

- Students will still be participating in recess.
- Smaller groups of classes will be participating in recess at one time.

#### **6. Lunch**

- PreK-6<sup>th</sup> grade will eat lunch in their classrooms for the start of the school year.
- 7<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> will eat in the gym at the lunch tables.
- Proper sanitation of tables will be completed after lunch.
- Students in all grades will wash hands before lunch.

#### **7. Drop off**

- Only parents of preschoolers may bring their children inside of the school building.
- K-12 students will go directly to their classrooms.
- No student may enter before 7:45.
- All students should be checked by parent before entering the building to make sure there are no signs of illness.
- If Coshocton County becomes red, student temperatures will be taken upon arrival.

#### **8. Pick up**

- We will be utilizing the same style of pick up line that we did for 2019-2020 school year.
- All Preschool-6<sup>th</sup> grade parents should remain in the pick up line until your child is brought out to your car.
- 7-12<sup>th</sup> grade students will walk to their vehicle at dismissal time.
- No parents should enter the building for dismissal.

#### **9. Water**

- Water fountains will be off limits.
- Water bottles will be allowed to be brought from home for each student.
- Water bottles should have child's name on them.

#### **10. Transportation**

- All bus students must follow the guidelines set by their bus district.
